Relocation of the parking deck at Medicinaregatan 18

The parking deck at Medicinaregatan 18 has now been dismantled and relocated. Over the summer, the structure will be fully reused (100%) and reassembled at IKEA's headquarters in Älmhult. The area where the parking deck previously stood has reopened for parking. Later this summer, the site will be further improved to enhance safety and create a more welcoming campus environment.

Food and foodtrucks

Bistro Science serves a daily lunch for SEK 99, with additional options including poké bowls, ramen and light refreshments. Opening hours are 08:30–15:30. On Fridays, charcoal-grilled burgers are served at great value, weather permitting. The space is also available to book for breakfast events and similar occasions.

The existing food truck location by the Lundberg Laboratory has now been relocated to Academicum, meaning that on certain days, two food trucks will be available in the same area.

Parcel lockers at Medicinaregatan 9D

PostNord will soon be installing five new parcel lockers outside the entrance to Medicinaregatan 9D, Health Innovation Labs. The lockers will be available for both deliveries and collections, providing an enhanced service on campus.

Bicycle parking

All covered bicycle parking facilities on campus have recently been replaced.

Window replacements at Medicinarelängan

The window replacement works at the Anatomy building are now complete.

Window replacement works at Histology are currently in progress and are expected to be completed in week 22. Further window replacements across Medicinarelängan will follow.

LED lighting

The replacement of indoor lighting with LED is ongoing across campus and is currently underway at Academicum, with completion expected after the summer holidays.

Next in line are the Hasselblad Laboratory and LNC, where the design phase will begin shortly, with installation scheduled to start in late spring.

Biodiversity

In the clearing below Lyktan, we will be carrying out measures during autumn 2025 and spring 2026 to enhance biodiversity. We will be installing bee and pollinator hotels and supplementing existing plantings with species that support wild bees.

Road safety

In connection with the City of Gothenburg's development of a new residential area and preschool on Guldhedsgatan, the City and Akademiska Hus are jointly planning improvements to the junction where
