## Parking

The area where the parking deck previously stood at **Medicinaregatan 18** has reopened for parking. After the summer, the site will be further improved to enhance safety and security on campus.

The car park at **EBM (Rundeln)** is closed due to the ongoing refurbishment of the building, where a tower crane will be installed. The closure is expected to remain in place for the foreseeable future.

The car park outside **Odontologen** now has a maximum parking time of **two hours** in the row closest to the building, to ensure that patients are able to find parking during the day.

## Spring event on campus – 12 May

On 12 May, Akademiska Hus hosted a spring event on campus, offering freshly brewed premium coffee and cinnamon buns. During the event, we shared information about upcoming investments and new outdoor activities planned for 2026.

Visitors had the opportunity to share their thoughts and ideas on campus development and take part in a competition.

Students and staff met representatives from Akademiska Hus, as well as colleagues from Bistro Science, Piffel and Friskis&Svettis. Over the course of the day, we handed out 400 freshly

baked cinnamon buns and 300 cups of premium coffee.

## Food and food trucks

Bistro Science serves a daily lunch special for SEK 99. Visitors can also purchase poke bowls, ramen and a selection of coffee and pastries. The restaurant is open from 08:30 to 15:30 until 5 June and will reopen on 31 August. Café Anatomen and Hälsocafét will also be closed for the summer during this period. Salt & Syra will be closed from Midsummer Eve (19 June) and will reopen on 10 August.



The existing food truck location near Lundberg Laboratory has now been relocated to Academicum, meaning that on some days there will be two food trucks operating at the same location.

## Parcel lockers at Medicinaregatan 9D

PostNord has installed five new parcel lockers outside the entrance to Medicinaregatan 9D (Health Innovation Labs). The lockers are available for both deliveries and parcel collection, providing an enhanced service for students, staff and visitors on campus.

## Window replacement works at Medicinarlängan

Window replacement works are currently underway in the Histology section of Medicinarlängan. The project is expected to be completed in week 22.

Additional window replacement projects are planned across other parts of Medicinarlängan in the coming months.

## LED lighting upgrades

The replacement of indoor lighting with LED lighting is continuing across the campus. The upgrade is currently underway at Academicum and is expected to be completed in September.

The next buildings scheduled for LED lighting upgrades are Hasselblad Laboratory and LNC, with work planned to take place during autumn 2026.

## Outdoor environment

Work at Återbruksparken will begin in week 24. The project includes the installation of new seating areas, improvements to the surrounding natural landscape, and the replacement of the existing asphalt path with a new gravel pathway designed to provide better accessibility.

## Traffic safety

As part of the City of Gothenburg's development of a new residential area and preschool along Guldhedsgatan, the city and Akademiska Hus are jointly planning improvements to the junction where Medicineregatan splits towards the Biomedical Library and continues past the allotment gardens alongside Guldhedsgatan. The redesign will make it clearer how motorists, cyclists and pedestrians should navigate and interact at the intersection, improving safety and accessibility for all road users. The improvement works are expected to begin during autumn 2026.



## Zoologen

The scaffolding is currently being dismantled. The first tenants are scheduled to move in during December. Friskis&Svettis is planning a soft opening in mid-December.

## New on campus – Activity box with games and sports equipment

Something new arrived on campus in April! A Piffel box has been installed on the grassy area near Hälsovetarbacken – an activity box filled with games and sports equipment that can be borrowed free of charge.
